breeze from N.E. by E. S.E. and fair weather.
Seeing S.W. by S. Lat. 27.51 N.
Lon. 29.25 W.

Light variable winds from
N. and E. with some light showers. Spoke
Lark Christy, from Bombay bound to Swin-
rock. Bound S.E. W. Lat. 26.16 N.
Lon. 29.23 W.

from N.E. and cloudy. Latter part fresh breeze
from S.E. by E. bound S.S.W. Lat. 23.49 N.
