Thursday Sept. 22nd
Commenced with moderate breeze from E. S.E. and fine weather. Latter part hauled to N. N.W. Steering S. by W.
Lat. 14. 57 S.
Lon. 24. 44 W.

Friday Sept. 23rd
First part light breeze from N. N.W. Middle part squally. Latter part fair with fresh breeze from S. S.W. Saw three sails.
Lat. 16. 58 S.
Lon. 23. 13 W.

Saturday Sept. 24th
First part wind from S. S.W. and pleasant. Latter part hauled to W. S.W. with heavy swell from S. Saw a sail steering to S. Steering by the wind S. by E. and S.
Lat. 17. 12 S.
Lon. 26. 53 W.

Sunday Sept. 25th
Fresh breeze from N. S.W. and W. with fair weather. Saw hump backs steering by the wind to S.
Lat. 18. 51 S.

Moderate breeze from N. and clear weather.
Lat. 20. 26 S.

Tuesday Sept. 27th
First part light breeze from N. and cloudy. Middle calm. Latter part wind N. W. hauled to S. W. by lunar. 25. 40 W. ch. 26. 59 W.

Wednesday Sept. 28th
Fresh breeze from N. W. First part. Middle squally wind hauled to S. W. Latter part fair wind hauling to S. At sunset doubled reefed fore & Miz. Sails. Saw
Lat. 23. 11 S.
Lon. 27. 57 W.

Thursday Sept. 29th
First part strong breeze from S. by E. and squally. Latter part moderate with fair weather. Saw 2 sails.
Lat. 24. 03 S.
Lon. 30. 00 W.

Friday Sept. 30th
Fresh breeze and pleasant steering S.W. wind S.
Lat. 25. 19 S.
Lon. 31. 40 W.

Saturday Oct. 1st
Fine breeze from S. S.E. and fair weather steering S.W.
