Sunday Apr. 25th 1854

all clear. Light breeze and calm
Course N.W. by W. Lat. 0. 28. N. Lon. 167. 25 E.

Monday Apr. 26th

Fine breeze from N.E. the first part, latter part light air and some rain. Course N.W. Lat. 1. 22. N. Lon. 166. 15 E.

Tuesday Apr. 27th

First part light air, latter part fresh breeze from N.E. Stopped down 47 Hs. oil. Course N.W. Lat. 2. 32. N. Lon. 165. 54 E.

Wednesday Apr. 28th

Fresh trades and cloudy. At 1 P.M. made Omalan or Strong Is. bearing N.W. by N. Lat. 4. 30. N. Lon. 163. 02 E.

Thursday Apr. 29th

Strong breezes and a good rain. Spent N.W. till day light then N. N. W. Lat. 6. 42. N. Lon. 161. 02 E.

Friday Apr. 30th

Fine breeze and squally. Spent N. N. W. Lat. 9. 08. N. Lon. 159. 20 E.

Saturday Apr. 29th

Light breeze and squally. Course N. N. W. Lat. 9. 20. N. Lon. 157. 30 E.

Sunday Apr. 30th

First part light breezes and squally. latter part fine breeze and fair. Course N.W. by N. Lat. 10. 13. N. Lon. 155. 30 E.

Tuesday May 2nd

Wednesday May 3rd

Fine breeze, latter part showery. Course N.W. by N. Lat. 11. 54. N. Lon. 149. 50 E.

Thursday May 4th

Cloudy with light breeze. Course N.W. by N. Lat. 12. 29. N. Lon. 148. 00 E.

Friday May 5th

Fine breeze and cloudy. Bent cable and got anchors of the boat. Course N.W. by N. Lat. 12. 54. N. Lon. 146. 00 E.

Saturday May 6th

Fine breeze and fair. At 15 m. off N. N. W. made Guam. Took a pilot at 12 m. and came to anchor at 1 P.M. in 23 fms. of Apia. Got a raft ashore for water. At Apia, Guam

Sunday May 7th

A few showers. Boat and watch on liberty. Apia

Monday May 8th

Getting water, fair. Apia

Tuesday May 9th

Showering water and getting recruits. Apia
