

Journal of a voyage to the N. Pacific

Tuesday Aug 8th 1854 First part fresh breeze from S. fine weather, latter part light breeze from S. ships. Employed boiling
Saghalian Bay

Wednesday Aug 9th Commenced with fine breeze from S. Ancho & drewed from a bow head. S. M. S. boat came out, fell calm, lowered with the ship, Anchored in  Saghalian Bay

Thursday Aug 10th Calm & foggy. Anchored with lower. Commenced cutting at 10 A.M. finished at 8 P.M.
Saghalian Bay

Friday Aug 11th Calm the first part, latter part fresh breeze from S. At 10 P.M. took our anchor, saw Cape Praya bearing N. E. dist. 20 miles, had dragged 10 miles. Saw 1 ship boiling

Saturday Aug 12th Fresh breeze from S. S. M. S. Ancho. Hove down 60 lbs oil. Saw 1 ship, & a bark at anchor

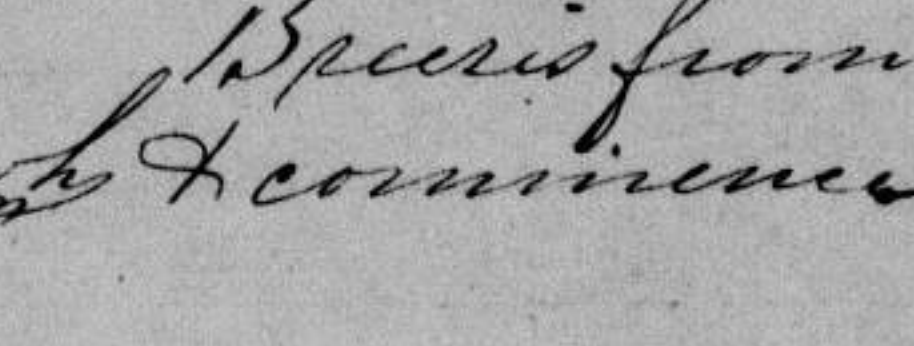
Sunday Aug 13th First part fresh breeze from S. E. latter part from S. E. fine weather. Hove down 60 lbs oil

Monday Aug 14th Fine breeze from S. E. & clear latter part calm. Anchored by Kedge in 9 fms. Finished boiling at 12 M.

Tuesday Aug 15th Light baffling air from S. E. & foggy. Finished drawing down

Wednesday Aug 16th Weather the same. Lowered for up without success. Picked up a dead  Sowed him to ship, & anchored at sunset. 6 ships in sight

Thursday Aug 17th Breeze from S. & S. E. with fine weather. Put in  & commenced boiling at 1 P.M. took our anchor.

Friday Aug 18th Commenced with fresh breeze from S. Middle calm & foggy, latter part fine breeze from S. E. Finished boiling at 5 P.M.

Saturday Aug 19th All then 24 hrs light air & calm. Drawing oil.

Sunday Aug 20th Light breeze from S. E. fine weather. Hove down 60 lbs oil. Saw 1 ship, & a bark at anchor. Finished drawing oil. spoke bark. Peruvian of Balapargis, 12 hrs

Monday Aug 21st Fresh breeze from S. E. cloudy. Ship O. anvan Bragg of Fall River.
Saghalian Bay

Tuesday Aug 22nd Southerly winds & heavy. At 9 A.M. waist boat struck a wh. got stove & lost. Saw bark boat saved up. Took him to ship at 12 M. & kept off. At 1 P.M. got a crowd the current. Spoke the Man Charin. Handed of New Bedford, Mass. Anchored in 12 fms at 1 P.M. Rainy
