Tuesday Jan. 9th 1855

Fine breeze from S. E. and
E. S. E. with cloudy weather. Heaving by the wind
Lat. 21.29 S.

Wednesday Jan. 10th

Fresh breeze from S. E. and
E. with some rain. By the wind
No observation

Thursday Jan. 11th

Strong breeze from E. and rain.
At 6 A. M. hauled topsail and set
topsails, hauled jib and spanker, and set S. E. hand
ed mainsail.
No observation

Friday Jan. 12th

Gale moderates, made some
sail. Middle part heavy squalls, wind haul-
ing to S. E. E. shortened sail to double reefed
Main E. sail. Bent new fore topmast stay
sail, Heaving by the wind to S. W. W. Lat. 33. 89 S.
Lon. 163. 07 W.

Saturday Jan. 13th

Strong breeze from S. E. and
fair weather. At 7 P. M. wore ship to E. by S. and
set the mainsail. Saw a sail to leeward. Set the
jib at 1 A. M. Lat. 53. 33 S.
Lon. 166. 55 W.

Sunday Jan. 14th

First part strong breeze from
S. and fair weather, latter part moderate, made all
sail. By the wind S. E. Lat. 54. 15 S.
Lon. 164. 55 W.

Bedford on board bark Sarah Sheaf. Capt. Gifford

Monday Jan. 15th

Light air from S. E. and cloudy
By the wind East. Lat. 34. 39 S.
Lon. 162. 54 W.

Tuesday Jan. 16th

First part light baffling air and
fine weather, latter part fine breeze from S. E. and
E. by S. Lat. 34. 37 S.
Lon. 162. 36 W.

Wednesday Jan. 17th

Fine breeze from E. and E. S.
E. with fine weather. By the wind S. E. Lat. 37. 16 S.
Lon. 163. 38 W.

Thursday Jan. 18th

Fresh breeze from S. E. and
cloudy. By the wind S. E. Lat. 39. 45 S.
Lon. 163. 53 W.

Friday Jan. 19th

First part fine breeze from S. E.
latter part light breeze and cloudy Lat. 42. 03 S.
Lon. 164. 39 W.

Saturday Jan. 20th

First part light breeze from S. E.
latter part haul to S. and W. S. W. Set top gallant, top-
mast and lower ending sail. Course S. E. Lat. 43. 18 S.
Lon. 163. 08 W.

Sunday Jan. 21st

First part fine breeze from W. S. W.
and fair weather, latter part strong breeze from S. E.
and squally. Course S. by S. Lat. 44. 04 S.
Lon. 161. 11 W.

Monday Jan. 22nd

First part strong breeze from S.
by W. and squally. hauled top gallant sail, latter
part moderate, made all sail. Course E. by S. Lat. 45. 07 S.
Lon. by lunar 156. 53 by Chron 156. 48 W.
