Tuesday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup> 1855 Pleasant gales from S.W. and squally. Course E.S.E. Lat. 46. 08 S. Lon. 154. 00 W.

Wednesday Jan 24<sup>th</sup> First part fine breeze from S.W. latter part light air. Course E. by S. Lat. 47. 16 S. Lon. 151. 00 W.

Thursday Jan 25<sup>th</sup> Light air from S.W. first part, latter part fine breeze from S.W. Course E. by S. Lat. 47. 44 S. Lon. 149. 23 W.

Friday Jan 26<sup>th</sup> Fine breezes from W.S.W. and clear weather. Course E. by S. Lat. 48. 54 S. Lon. 146. 04 W.

Saturday Jan 27<sup>th</sup> First part strong breeze from S.W. and cloudy, latter part rain. At 5 P.M. wind hauled to W. with clear weather. Course E. by S. Lat. 50. 20 S. Lon. 140. 24 W.

Sunday Jan 28<sup>th</sup> Fresh breeze from S.W. with some squalls. Carried away foremast and rigging sail boom. Course E. by S. Lat. 51. 16 S. Lon. 137. 19 W.

Monday Jan 29<sup>th</sup> First part fine breezes from S.W. latter part hauls to W. and cloudy weather. Course E. by S. No observation

Tuesday Jan 30<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from W.S.W. latter part light breezes from S. thick fog and rain. Course E. by S. No observation

Sheaf from Honolulu to New Bedford

Wednesday Jan 31<sup>st</sup> Commenced with light breeze from S.W. At 8 P.M. hauled to S. and freshened to a gale shortened sail to double reef and hauled mainmast, latter part moderates and hauls to W. set single reefed top sails. At 7 P.M. closed reef. Thick squally weather. Course E. Bar. 28. 80 Lat. 53. 58 S. Lon. 125. 35 W.

Thursday Feb 1<sup>st</sup> Gale from W. with heavy squalls and some rain. Under close reef. Course E. Bar. 28. 31 Lat. 54. 23 S. Lon. 122. 10 W.

Friday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> First part gale moderates, set double reefed top sails, latter part made all sail with fine breeze from W.S.W. Saw 3 large icebergs. Course E. by S. Bar. 28. 50 Lat. 54. 53 S. Lon. 117. 53 W.

Saturday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> Fine breezes from W.S.W. with some squalls. Past an iceberg at 9 P.M. Course E. Bar. 28. 95 Lat. 55. 16 S. Lon. 113. 39 W.

Sunday Feb 4<sup>th</sup> First part light air from S.W. and cloudy, latter part fine breeze from S. and clear weather. Course E. by S. Bar. 29. 10 Lat. 56. 28 S. Lon. 110. 19 W.

Monday Feb 5<sup>th</sup> First part fine breeze from S.W. fine weather, latter part hauls to W.S.W. and increases to a gale. At 8 P.M. shortened sail to close reefed top sail. Course E. by S. Bar. 29. 05 Lat. 55. 36 S. Lon. 105. 55 W.
