

Remarks on Board Bar N Clara Bell

Thursday July 15th 1858

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. course N.W. the Islands in sight at sunset shortened sail and started West made part bying Shack Valler part started N.W. saw a Carib and and in hopes to see a whale soon

Lat 40° 38' 15" Long 24° 50'

Friday 16th

Commenced with light winds from N.E. Bark heading N.W. with all sail set at 4 P.M. saw a Bark Boiling and we hope to be doing the same soon day tomorrow made part calm Valler part wind from S.W. course N.W. got saw most every thing but sperm whales and we are looking sharp to see them and hope to see soon

Lat 40° 38' 44" Long 30° 10' 10"

Saturday 17th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. in mainsail & set at 4 P.M. made shift to N.E. at 7 P.M. spoke N.W. Wallen Coffin Master which reports Ship Leagues N.W. with 40 Bbls made part wind strong breeze Valler part at 3 A.M. heard Ship to N.W. started N.E. at daylight made sail the Ship standing S.W.

Lat 40° 39' 09" Long 36° 25' 10"

Sunday 18th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.E. heading N.W. at sunset moved the Boat to Port the crew think they are any more now we want a whale Monday

made part calm Valler part wind from South & West heading in for Flores at 10 A.M. went on shore

Bark lying off and on

Cruising in the vicinity of the Western Islands

Monday July 19th 1858

Commenced with moderate breezes from South. Bark lying off & on Flores made part the same Ship & some more

Tuesday 20th

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from Westward left Flores to S.W.

Wednesday 21st

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.W. Tackled to S.W. made part heading N.W. Valler part at 6 A.M. saw Killis weather clear but nothing in sight

Lat 40° 38' 48" Long 32° 20' 10"

Thursday 22nd

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from Westward started off E. N.E. at 2 P.M. started E. at sunset shortened sail & layed with head yards & back made part the same Valler part heading forward and started E. N.E. Flores in sight at 11 A.M. started S.W.

Lat 40° 39' 39" Long 31° 14' 10"

Friday 23rd

Commenced with strong breeze from S.W. made Ship and started S.W. made part under short sail Valler part made all sail heading in shore

Lat 40° 39' 19" Long 31° 04' 10"

Saturday 24th

Commenced with moderate breezes from Westward at 2 P.M. Tackled off shore saw Grampack at sunset shortened sail in hopes to see some whale tomorrow and found good ground we may for we are in want of cod very much at midnight heard Ship in shore Valler part at daylight made sail weather fine nothing in sight

Sailed within 15 miles
