Saturday 7th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W.
Course N.W. under easy sail Mianell part
the same same part made all sail same
the same nothing in sight

whale and hope I shall get one if it
is good size if not I am content with

Sunday Aug 8th 1858

Commenced with moderate breeze from E.N.E.
Bark heading N.W. & with all sail set
at 5 P.M. sail & landed for Blackfish but got
none at 6 came in Board at sunset shorted
sail for a whale Mianell & Vatten part weather
fine saw several ships Bark Buge & Schooner
but no whales at Mianell Jack M. & E. M.

Monday Aug 9th

Commenced with moderate breeze from E.N.E.
Bark heading N.W. & with all sail set at sun
set shorted sail Mianell & Vatten part weather
fine saw several vessels in sight but no whales

Lat 4. 0. 36. 17. Long 36. 00. W.

Tuesday 10th

Commenced with moderate breeze from
E.N.E. Bark heading N. with all sail set
at sunset commenced with Bark Cecilia N.W.
Coast Master 27 Month 5-50 Spinn & Union Master
part of Mianell out 80 Bbls Mianell part heading
to the Northward Vatten part at 6 P.M. saw a Bark
measuring Board Ship and shored for her
saw her Bark & but nothing more

Long 35. 37. W.

Wednesday 11th

Commenced with moderate breeze from
Northward Bark heading to the Eastward
or rather South & East nothing in sight
but Barks but we still hope in that
course Port and trust that we may get
a whale but very Mianell & Vatten part
weather fine saw from Westward Bark
heading to the Northward saw Blackfish
but no more
