

Wednesday Sept 1st 1858

Commenced with light airs & calm
Bark off St. Miguel at 3 P.M. Boat went
and there to by to sell some tobacco but
got tired at sunset Boat came and then
Middie & Valler part came back

Lat 46° 36.55' N Long 25° 33'

Thursday Sept 2nd

Commenced with light breezes from North
Course South Middie & Valler part came
to see us but no whales

Lat 46° 35.47' N Long 25° 41'

Friday 3rd

Commenced with moderate breezes
from E.N.E. Bark heading from S.E. to N.W.
with all sail set with a hope of
singing sperm whales Middie (Valler part
wind and Baffin with rain

Lat 46° 35.37' N

Long 25° 00' W

Saturday 4th

Commenced with light airs & calm
many birds Porpoises and every thing but
sperm whale Middie & Valler part
Phaenurus breezes from N.W. Course S.E.
with all sail set saw two birds
but no whales

Long 25° 13' W

Sunday 5th

Commenced with moderate breezes
from N.W. Course S.E. with all sails set
at sunset shortened sail luffed
to the wind heading S.W. with full sail
Bark Middie part the same Valler part
at daylight started course S.E.

Lat 46° 32.23' N Long 24° 20' W

Monday Sept 6th 1858

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.W.
Course S.E. under easy sail saw a jumper but
no whales wish we could get a little oil
so as to make some good food for my
madder part called Valler part a light breeze from
S.E. Bark heading S.W. with all sail set
saw some porpoises but no whales

Lat 46° 33.56' N Long 24° 26'

Tuesday 7th

Commenced with pleasant breezes from
S.E. Bark by the wind of up S.W. with all sail
set no whales Middie part weather & wind
the same Valler part under more south Bark
heading S.W. by W. with all sail set

Lat 46° 32.01' N Long 24° 14'

Wednesday 8th

Commenced with moderate breezes from
S.E. Bark heading S.W. by W. with all sail set
saw some jumpers no whales and time
is going but has will be and Middie & Valler
part light airs & calm saw one bird
but no whales

Lat 46° 30.21' N Long 24° 00'

Thursday 9th

Commenced with moderate airs from
South & East Bark heading S.W. by W.
with all sail set employed in making a Spunkin
leaf finished and put it up Middie &
Valler part weather the same but nothing
in sight we still hope and then better
fortune in store for us than we have had
up to this time God grant there may be for
my dear Parents sake
