Sunday 12th

Commenced with light and calm nothing in sight and no wind but made & Valler part the same one Bark in sight

Monday 13th

Commenced with light and calm course S by W one Bark in sight but no whales made & Valler part with some different as regards wind but as far as seeing whales is the same none as yet

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with light trades but from NW course S by W employed hauling a new Parting made & Valler part with the same wind from NE course S by W with all sail set nothing in sight
