Commenced with light Breeze from  
SE course NW at 3 1/2 PM saw the Isle  
of San Barray N. to Astoria about 3 leagues  
luffed 1- the wind by up N E & E  
middle part the same Vatter part 3/4  
saw Porpoises and many Birds but no Whales  
Lat 46 1/2 N Long 123 1/2 W

Monday 30th

Commenced with light breeze from ENE  
Bark heading NNE under easy sail  
middle part heading to NNE Vatter part  
Jacked to ESE at 4 1/2 PM Jacked to South  
with fine  
Lat 46 1/2 N Long 123 30 W

Tuesday 31st

Commenced with Pleasant Trades  
Bark on the North Star at sunset  
saw & hunted for Blackfish got two  
middle part heading N. ESE Vatter part  
head Ship to N. W. saw two vessels  
steering to Southward

Wednesday 1st Oct

Commenced with strong N E Trades  
Course South under easy sail at sunset  
shortened sail to double reefed topsails  
at 9 PM luffed to wind to ESE middle  
part blowing strong nothing in sight

Thursday 2nd Oct

Thursday Sept 30th

Commenced with strong N E Trades Bark on  
the Eastern Sack under short sail  
middle part the same Vatter part made  
some sail employed hauling Blackfish  
Lat 46 1/2 N Long 123 30 W

Friday 31st

Commenced with strong N E Trades Bark  
on the Eastern Sack by up ESE at 2 PM double  
reefed the topsails at 4 PM shortened of light  
middle part the same Vatter part off Island  
went in with a Boat
