Tuesday Nov 9th

Commenced with Pleasant breeze from Eastward Course S by W with all Masted sail set Middle part wind strong Vatter put more Pleasant saw any quantity of Fin back if we could only be fortunate enough to see Spence Whales half as plenty and have a little luck we would soon have some Oil Good grant we may soon

Wednesday Nov 10th

Commenced with light breeze from Eastward Course S by W Middle part wind 10 A.M. a breeze from NE corner the same saw Fin back

Thursday 11th

Commenced with Pleasant breeze from NE corner S by W toward Bay side for we feel in hopes to see some whales Middle & Vatter part weather thick saw some old deer how much we want some Oil but Good they will be done

Friday 12th

Commenced with light breeze from Northward stand West at sunset shortened sail Middle part light air & calm Vatter part a light breeze from NE at daylight made sail weather fine saw some squid and many birds but no Whales

Bound to the Pacific Ocean

Saturday Nov 13th 1858

Commenced with light breeze from NE Ship heading S by W to NW at sunset shortened sail with hopes of getting a whale Middle & Vatter part weather foggy saw a Bay & Ship Bordered the Brig it proved to be a Spaniard from N. B. ad bound to Spain

Long 51-52' W. Var. 11

Sunday 14th

Commenced with moderate breeze from Eastward Course Westward Bay side at 1 P.M. bordered the Ship Continued of heavy fog and Bordered to Copenhagen had lost some of her Spars & Sprung her Mainmast in a Gale from S by W to NW at sunset we shortened sail at midnight bore a Ship to the N. N. W. Vatter part at daylight made some sail at 7 A.M. took in the mainsail & jib stowed of M by S at 11 A.M. Sea too much and lost sight of Mainmast and Spencer heading S by E

Monday 15th

Commenced with strong Gale from E. N. E. Bark lying to under close reef a main topsail foresail & Spencer at 6 P.M. took in the foresail Bordered going toward change hope things will change for the better Middle & Vatter part blowing a heavy heavy Gale from E. S. E. to S. E. with sail set Bark lying to under close reef in air topsail Spencer and topsail stop sail
