Saw Whales but got none
hope we shall have better luck soon

Monday 30th
Commenced with strong trades boats in chase
of Whales

Tuesday 31st

Spoke Ship Edward Gay

saw many Sulfur Bottoms

Wednesday Aug 1st

no Whales

Sat. H. Beach way

Thursday 2nd
hope to see and get a sperm whale soon

Friday 3rd commenced with Barks on
and Edward Gay saw plenty of Finbacks

Saturday 4th

Sat 1.55.59 no Whales but we are so hope
Sun 1.60.30.27.11

Sunday 5th

Plenty Finbacks Charles Island in sight

Monday 6th

Commenced with B. H. Sun

Tuesday 7th no Whales

Wednesday 8th saw and got a Blackfish
got two more and hope and pray we may
get two sperm Whales soon

Thursday Aug 9th 1860
Commenced with strong trades and cloudy
but nothing in sight

Friday 10th

Commenced with thick weather but played
Boiling Blackfish nothing in sight

Saturday 11th

Commenced with thick weather nothing in sight
hope to see some soon sailing but long to see some
whales some part saw only two Blackfish

Sunday 12th

Commenced with strong trades Barks on the
Eastern Tack and it is very Breezy
and I hope that we shall be blessed
with some sperm Whales Monday night
Middle part the same latter part saw many
Finbacks at 11 AM saw a Breeze to the E. N. E
made us sail and run for it but saw nothing
more

Monday 13th

Commenced with moderate trades strong
E. N. E but saw nothing more of the Breeze
and hope we shall see some sperm Whales
in the morning Middle and latter part with
fine but nothing in sight

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with moderate trades
and cloudy at sunset Tacked Ship to West
and commenced Boiling Blackfish and
hope Tuesday to Boil some sperm Whales
Boiled soon had great fire and a great
much Boiling latter part saw nothing
for Blackfish but got none
