

Sunday 10th March 1861

Commenced with squally weather but we hope for better weather and some whales with smilcs and Phasant lookd Vatz Obs 32.08 T
Vom. Ch. 90.48 W

Monday 11th

Commenced with strong Breeze from S.E. at 4 p. M. Sacked to E. & E. Middle part weather the same Vatter part more moderate nothing in sight Vatz Obs 31.50 T
Vom. Ch. 89.20 W

Tuesday 12th

Commenced with moderate Breeze from S.E. Back on the Starboard side saw a Bark standing to S.W. Middle part saw Vatter part Phasant but nothing in sight hope to have a sight at some whales soon Vatz Obs 31.56 T
Vom. Ch. 89.20 W

Wednesday 13th

Commenced with Phasant Breeze from S.E. Back by up N.E. & E. to E.N.E. nothing in sight but hope to see some whales by some middle Vatter part by up E.N.E. until 11.30 M. Sacked to the Southward by up S.E. & E. S.W. Vatz Obs 30.58 T
Vom. Ch. 88.45 W

Thursday 14th

Commenced with light Breeze from S.E. to S.E. Back by up from S.W. to S.E. and we are by much in want of some whales Middle Vatter part weather calm Vatz Obs 31.42 T
Vom. Ch. 88.52 W

Friday 15th

Commenced with light air and calm saw some whales and hope soon to see some Middle and Vatter part wind from the Westward

Saturday March 16th 1861

Commenced with strong westerly winds came E. & S. Middle & Vatter part the same Vatz

Sunday 17th

Commenced with strong W. winds came E. Middle part strong strong at daylight saw many whales distant at 10 A.M. and in evening fishing saw three whales got some fish

Monday 18th

Commenced with Phasant Breeze from S.W. Middle and Vatter part calm Vatz Obs 31.42 T
Vom. Ch. 88.45 W

Tuesday 19th

Calm nothing in sight

Wednesday 20th

Commenced with moderate air and calm all hands employed doing nothing Vatz Obs 31.22 T
Vom. Ch. 87.13 W

Thursday 21st

Commenced with light Breeze from S.E. Back by the wind by up N.E. & E. saw many Puffins

Friday 22nd

Anchored at Salchuan

April 1st

Shipped 130 Bbls of Bark Amara

April 2nd

Shipped 373 Bbls of Bark Vagance

Tuesday April 3rd

Commenced with strong westerly winds Vatter part wind from S.W. got some fish and put to sea
