Commenced with moderate Trades Bar. in
 different Tracks or insufficient Tracks nothing in sight
 but Banks at 6 PM Capt Swain of John A. Parker
 came on Board and spent the evening.

Tuesday 11th

Nothing in sight and had only Reads when the weather
 but at noon and pray we may see something soon
 middle and latter part weather good

Wednesday 12th

Commenced with John A. Parker
 nothing in sight
 Charles Deane in sight

Thursday 13th

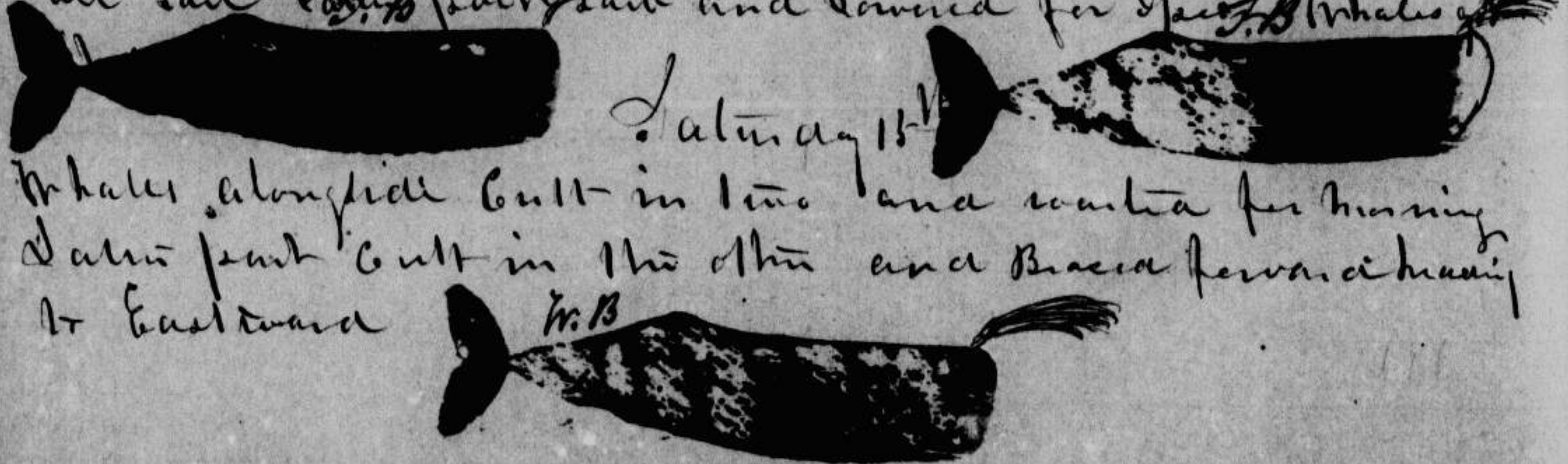
Several Banks in sight and our ship superseded by the
 keeper commenced with regular Beat Marks and Bank
 after Allen Mark

Friday 14th

Plenty of ships but no Whales middle part Bank near
 all sail set and lowered for speed Whales

Saturday 15th

Whales along side of the ship in line and waiting for hunting
 also part of the ship and a brace forward heading
 to Eastward



Sunday June 16th 1861

Commenced with several Banks in sight but none
 sailing and we feel ever thankful to the all wise ruler
 of all things Islands in sight

Monday 17th

weather Pleasant finished sailing and sadly in want

Tuesday 18th

Commenced with Bangui Mary Ann and Sea Queen

Wednesday 19th

weather Good and we sadly in want of some more Whales
 not meaning to say that we don't feel wonderfully favored
 but we feel the need of some more very much
 God grant we may soon have enough to go Home with
 a good supply middle & latter part weather Good but no Whales
 Lat 46.23 Lon 66.90.50

Thursday 20th

Commenced with Pleasant weather but nothing in sight
 but we hope on other hope Lat 46.26 Lon 67.00

Friday 21st

Commenced with moderate weather and we in want
 of Whales but none in sight

Saturday 22nd

Commenced with moderate Trades Plenty Sulfur Bottoms

Sunday 23rd

Commenced with moderate Trades Bar. Concluding
 at 2 PM spoke the ship Gen. Scott Jan. Harmer El. and a private
 11 minutes out 120 Bells

Monday 24th

Commenced with moderate Trades, Commenced with the
 Gen. Scott

Tuesday 25th

Commenced with strong Trades & Sulfur Bottoms
