from E to E & S with a sail at the side & saw
part the same

Lat 40° 44' N Long 120° 20' W

Friday 15th

Commenced with strong trade Bar R.
by up E Middle & S. saw part the same

Lat 40° 12' N Long 121° 35' W

Saturday 16th

Commenced with moderate trade
saw part saw the same

Commenced with moderate trade Bar R.
by up E Middle & S. saw the same
Lat 40° 12' N Long 121° 35' W
Lacka Middle part weather fine S. saw part
at Musoran. Anchored at Sun. bar 4 fathoms
with 30 fathoms of chain

Monday 18

Even. foggy getting warmer

Tuesday 19th

Ship ready for sea at 11 A.M. got under
weigh and put to sea and was happy
to be favoured with a fine good luck

Wednesday 20th

Two merchant vessels in sight Middle
part blowing strong took in the light sails
and heaved the topsails Lat 40° 40' N Long 121° 10' W

Thursday 21st

Commenced with strong trade Bar R. heading
in shore by up E to E & S at 2 P.M. Bar R.
of shore by up E to E & S Middle & S. saw
the same Bar R. towards Plover

Friday 22nd

Commenced with strong trade Bar R. by
in shore towards Middle & S. saw part the same

Saturday 23rd

Trying to get to Plover at 11 A.M. Bar R. of the Plover
at Musoran. S. saw Bar R. of Plover
