

Monday Feb 6th 1860

Commenced with Pleasant Trades from strong N.W. luffed to the wind to Eastward by up E.N.E. nothing in sight to day but we will wait for the morning breeze and then part weather the same but nothing in sight

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 14' W.

Tuesday 7th

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Breeze and the Southern Sack V. up N.W. at 6 P.M. commenced with Ship Hens of N.W. tacked to N.W. at 11 P.M. but 1300 at midnight heard ship to Eastward S.W. part to

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 28' W.

Wednesday 8th

Commenced with light Trades and Pleasant Breeze Ship by up E.N.E. Plenty of Ships but no Whales hoping to see some soon Midday and then part heading to the Eastward

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 07' W.

Thursday 9th

Commenced with moderate Trades and the weather at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Okean of Vicksburg Stanton Master 28 Months out 500 Bbls of Spum Midday part the same then part at 10 P.M. spoke and commenced with Ship Commodore Jones of Salisbury Jones Master 28 Months out 500 Bbls of Spum

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 07' W.

Friday 10th

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on N.W. luff in commencing with the Ship Midday and then part heading to the N.W.

Lat 40° 15' N. Long 114° 51' W.

Saturday 11th

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on N.W. luff E.N.E. saw many Porpoises & Blackfish Midday & then part heading to E.N.E. and N.E.

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 07' W.

Sunday Feb 12th 1860

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark heading to E.N.E. at 1 P.M. saw a Bark to the Northward started for it but it proved to be a S.W. Bark saw many Blackfish and hope to see Whales Monday next Midday & then part heading to the N.W. saw some ship

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 15' W.

Monday 13th

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on the N.W. luff at 5 P.M. saw an arrowhead for 13 Blackfish got seven Midday part Employed chasing Blackfish Bark on the Eastern Sack V. up N.W. part 1300 at 11 P.M. saw some ship but Spum Whales

Lat 40° 15' N. Long 114° 14' W.

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with Pleasant Trades at 5 P.M. saw and chased 12 Blackfish but got none hope and pray we shall get a Whale tomorrow if it blows still Midday part heading to the N.W. then part in Eastern Sack V. up E.N.E. Employed chasing Blackfish

Lat 40° 15' N. Long 114° 32' W.

Wednesday 15th

Commenced with moderate Trades Bark on the Eastern Sack V. up N.E. & E. Midday and then part the same saw and chased the Ship Henry of New Haven from Melbourne Borneo to Calcutta

Lat 40° 15' N. Long 114° 14' W.

Thursday 16th

Commenced with light Trades Bark on the Eastern Sack saw one Bark have seen Plenty Porpoises and hope soon to see Spum Whales Midday & then part calm saw Plenty Porpoises but no Whales

Lat 40° 14' N. Long 114° 14' W.

Friday 17th

Commenced with light Trades Bark on N.W. luff at same N.W. in the light Sails Midday part the same then part saw a Bark and saw some for Blackfish
