

Sunday March 12th 1860

Commenced with light Tides at 2 PM saw
and looked for Humpbacks should not be sunset
Boats came on Board and set part heading off shore
Vallu part heading in employed Boiling

Monday 13th

Commenced with moderate Tides Boat started
in shore at 2 PM saw and looked for Humpbacks
by get more at sunset Boats returned
midall part going back heading off shore
Vallu part heading in shore at 4 PM in evening
for Humpbacks struck and the seen seen

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with strong Tides Boats in Pursuit
of Humpbacks at 3 PM Boats returned and
midall part weather foggy Vallu part still in shore
and found the Boat

Wednesday 15th

Commenced with strong Tides Boats in Pursuit
of Humpbacks struck and lost a line
midall part heading off shore Vallu part heading in
at sunset foggy at 8 PM seen found and made in
to the Bay

Thursday 16th

Commenced with light Tides and that with
after Humpbacks but without success midall part
Vallu part heading off shore

Friday 17th

Commenced with strong Tides Boat off shore
by up at midall Vallu part weather good but no whales

Saturday

Commenced with light Tides and that with
Boat under full sail

Sunday March 19th 1860

Commenced with strong Tides Boat on the Easton Tack
but saw nothing in sight midall & Vallu part Tides
strong saw Humpbacks

Monday 20th

Commenced with strong Tides Boat on the Easton Tack
by up & N E under full sail at sunset saw a Ship
midall & Vallu part weather strong saw some Blackfish

Tuesday 21st

Commenced with strong Tides and strong Boat
on the Southern Tack by up & N E under double reefed sails
midall and Vallu weather the same Boat on the Easton
Tack by up N E & E - E N E

Wednesday 22nd

Commenced with strong Tides Boat on the Easton Tack
by up & N E at sunset took in jib and mainsail saw Blackfish
midall & Vallu part weather more moderate

Thursday 23rd

Commenced with strong Tides at sunset took in & W
midall part weather fine Vallu part weather the same
employed strong oil in main flatter

Friday 24th

Commenced with strong Tides Boat on the Easton
Tack by up from E to E N E under easy sail saw, strong
strong oil midall part sleeping Vallu part at day light
Commenced strong again

Saturday 25th

Commenced with Pleasant Tides Boat on the
Southern Tack by up & N E at 3 PM finished the
main part day midall part weather the same
Vallu part down ship to N E nothing in sight
but we hope and pray we may get some bit soon

Sunday 26th

Commenced with light Tides
