nothing in sight at sunset huffed to the land
and shortened sail and we sincerely
hope we may get some Whales soon
for we are sadly in want. M. J. J. part
began ship to NE. Vatter part started off N. by N.
saw or say nothing in sight

Long 128° 13' 10" W

Monday 10th

Commenced with Pleasant Trade at 3 PM
huffed to the river to the S. W. and Bark in
sight at 6 PM spoke and commenced with
Bark President of New Bedford Mary Mack
5 months out 120 Bbls mixed seal heading to the
Southward Vatter part at daylight made sail
course N by N

Lat 46° 12' 38" N Long 128° 13' 00" W

Tuesday 11th

Commenced with strong Trade Bark came
N by N the President in sight M. J. J. & Vatter part
went to cloudy land in bark

Lat 46° 11' 49" N Long 128° 16' 00" W
Wednesday 12th

Commenced with strong Trade Bark came
N by N with all dependent sails set
at sunset shortened sail and huffed to the
land Eastward made part began ship to N
Vatter part at daylight made sail and huffed
to the river nothing in sight but we are looking
to get some Whales soon

Long 128° 15' 00" W

Thursday 13th

Commenced with Pleasant Trade
Came N by N at sunset started to the N. and Vatter
the same Bark came N by N Lat 46° 15' 55" N Long 128° 16' 16" W

Friday April 13th 1860

Commenced with Pleasant Trade Bark came N by N
Bark a New Superior saw some Blackfish but no Whales
hope and pray we may soon get some for we are
poor and sadly in want M. J. J. & Vatter part the same
Employed many sails to

Saturday 14th

Commenced with Pleasant Trade Bark came N by N
Employed many sails saw Porpoises and hope
to have some Whales soon saw part M. J. J. &
Vatter part the same the same struck two Porpoises
and we hope soon to get some sperm Whales

Sunday 15th

Commenced with Pleasant Trade Bark came
N by N with all sail set nothing in sight
M. J. J. & Vatter part the same

Monday 16th

Commenced with Pleasant Trade Bark came N by N
at 5 PM saw and saw some for Blackfish got
three M. J. J. part heading to the S. E. Vatter part
began ship to N by N saw Blackfish

Tuesday 17th

Commenced with strong Trade Bark came
Bark on the Eastern Jack off up N by N
at sunset took in the light sails to try and
get a Whale tomorrow M. J. J. & Vatter part
saw light

Wednesday

Commenced with moderate Trade
Bark to the same of up N by N M. J. J. part
saw Vatter part saw light from S. E.
Bark to the river by up N by N
