Monday 23rd

Commenced with moderate trades and
Pleasant Course 6 N with all sail set
middle & Vatter part weather fine saw Blackfish

Tuesday 24th

Commenced with moderate Breezes from
SW Course 6 N with all sail set Middle part
by up to 10 M Vatter part the same in sight made
all sail

Wednesday Apr 25th 1860

Commenced with light Breezes and sailing Bark heading
off shore Vatter part Course 6 N got to the Port
Bark 12 N from the land

Thursday 26th

Commenced with moderate Breezes from West
to SW Bark heading to leeward but saw whips
to be able to get a whale to commence

Starboard side

Friday 27th

Commenced with light Baffling Breezes from
SW at 5 PM at 5 PM Lark off shore
In hopes to get up to Anchor to pursue
Middle & Vatter part Baiting to windward for same

Saturday 28th

Commenced with strong Breezes from the SW
at 3 PM came to Anchor in 5 fathoms water
of same at 10 PM

Sunday 29th

Commenced with light Breezes from SW
at 9 PM at 9 PM got under weigh and a Port to sea
Vat 4 Ob 5 7 11 N Vor 6 Ch. 15 25 50

Monday 30th

Commenced with strong Breezes from SW
Bark heading off shore by up to 10 M with all
sail set at sunset bark in the light sail
and Mackerel Middle part bark ship Vatter part
Lark 1 to Anchor

Tuesday 1st

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from SW
Bark heading to NW Middle & Vatter part the same
saw Porpoises and hopes to have a whale soon
