Back on the Eastern Tack by up S & E
saw Fin back's Minnie & saw Weather fin
saw Black fish and hope in many
some Whales seen
Sat. 5th 1860 1.00

Wednesday 6th

Common with moderate
NW winds Back by the wind by up S & E
Middle & Waller part the same
Sat. 6th 1860 1.12

Thursday 7th

Common with Pleasant weather
but no Whales Middle part the same Waller part
saw the land Pt. St. Helena

Friday 8th

Common with moderate Breeze
from NW to NW Back by the wind by up S & E
saw Black fish & some

Saturday 9th

Common with a calm and nothing to
Middle & Waller part Calm
Sat. 9th 1860 1.12

Sunday June 10th 1860

Common with light Breeze
from NW wind Back by the wind by up S & E
Middle part wind very light Waller part wind
from the Northward

Monday 11th

Common with light Breeze from NW
Back by the wind by up NW Middle part strong
Waller part the same
Sat. 11th 1860 1.12

Tuesday 12th

Common with strong Trades
Back by the wind by up S & E at sunset Tacked
by up NW

Arrived at Payson

Common with Pleasant weather

Common with strong Trades Back
in a night Middle & Waller part strong
Common NW I by a New Page

Wednesday 20th

Common with strong Trades
Back heading to NW with all sail set saw
and lowered for Black fish at 5 P.M. but
got none hope land to see Whales
Middle & Waller part steady W saw many
Fin back's and Birds but not a single
in want of some Whales
