and Edward Gay saw Plenty of Finbacks

Plenty of Finbacks
Charles Island in sight

Monday 6th
hammed with B.W. 20
Tuesday 6th no Whales
Wednesday 7th saw and got a Blackfish

got two and hope and they are very

Thursday Aug 9th 1861
Commenced with strong trades and cloudy
but nothing in sight

Friday 10th
Commenced with thick weather but plenty of
Baiting Blackfish nothing in sight

Saturday 11th
Commenced with thick weather nothing in sight
hope to see some soon sailing but long to see some
whales same part saw any here Blackfish

Sunday 12th
Commenced with strong trades Bar N.W. 20
Eastern Jack and it is very Baiting day
and I hope that we shall be blessed
with some sperm Whales Monday night

Monday 13th
Middle part the same value part saw many
Finbacks at 11 A.M. saw a B.W. to the E.N.E
made new sail and run for it but saw nothing
more

Tuesday 14th
Commenced with moderate trades. Trade
E.N.E but saw nothing more of the B.W. 20
and hope we shall see some sperm Whales
in the morning Middle and same part will
find but nothing in sight

Wednesday 15th
Commenced with moderate trades
and cloudy at sunset Jacked Ship to the
and commenced Baiting Blackfish and
hope to see some sperm Whales

Thursday 16th
Baited some Cod grant since we part
pushed Baiting same part saw a B.W. 20
and Blackfish but got none

Friday 17th
Saw 3.11.12.50.11
