Commenced with moderate trades
Stood off N.E. saw Blackfish however but
got none Mice, and the same latter part
saw and turned for Blackfish got two

Thursday 16th

Commenced with moderate trades and cloudy
saw Blackfish however and got but
Mice, and weather fine saw Blackfish
Porpoises and many birds but no sperm whale
but we hope to see some soon

Lat 40° 25' N

Long 121° 40' W

Friday 17th

Commenced with moderate trades Back by the wind
N.E. saw many Porpoises latter part saw
and turned for Blackfish got none

Lat 40° 03' N Long 123° 00' W

Saturday 18th

Commenced with moderate trades
back by the wind by 8 P.M. saw Blackfish
and I should think we might be
favored with a sight at some sperm whale

Lat 40° 00' N Long 124° 00' W

Sunday 19th

Commenced with moderate trades at 3 P.M.
saw the land

Monday 20th

Lat 40° 00' N Long 124° 20' W

Commenced with moderate trades
Back by the wind. Tack saw two birds
in water part the same latter part saw ship and back

Tuesday 21st Lat 40° 00' N

Commenced with strong trade saw some N.W.
at sunset 2 P.M. saw by up N.W.

Wednesday Aug 22nd 1860

Commenced with moderate trades and good weather
saw many Porpoises struck three at sunset took in
the light sails and courses and hoisted ship to the
eastward Middle part calm latter part made all sail

Lat 40° 00' N Long 125° 00' W

Thursday 23rd

Commenced with moderate trades Back by the wind
by up N.W. at sunset took in the light sails and
courses Middle part the same latter part made all
sail saw three birds but no whale I don't know
much we want some oil God grant we may
soon get some food and fuel very miserable

Lat 40° 00' N Long 125° 00' W

Friday 24th

Commenced with fine weather and no whales
and we have seen but very few had good luck
may see some soon and get some oil for
oil ready in want Middle part made all
sail latter part spoke Bird weather fine N.W. for a
pleasant master 15 months out 500 lbs oil



Saturday 25th

Lat 40° 00' N Long 125° 00' W

Commenced with strong trade Back by the wind
by up N.W. at 2 P.M. saw sperm whales and turned
at 4 P.M. struck a large whale and got him
Middle part by the whale latter part
cutting at midnoon Capt. Cook of Back by last
same and Board

Lat 40° 00' N Long 125° 00' W

Sunday 26th

Commenced with strong trade completely calm
at 5 P.M. hauled down for the night and
saw no part the same latter part distressed
