Commenced with Strong Trades and squally saw
the Bark by sunset saw Finbacks and several hope
to see Sperm Whales soon for we are now ready for
some more Middie part in the Western part Vatter part

Thursday 6th
Commenced with Strong Trades Bark on the Eastern
part by up & E saw many Finbacks at sunset
saw to see the surface of the water with hopes of seeing Whales
Middie part squally Vatter part clear ship to W.W.
and commenced storing oil
