Commenced with light Trades and Cloudy
Bark on the Eastern Tack by up & E Middle part
the same Vatter part at 2nd M. Beard Ship by up N. by W.

Sunday 7th
Vat by Oct 6th N. by W. 86.45 W.

Commenced with light Trades and Cloudy
at 1 P.M. Tack Red by up & E. I saw Comfish
and shortened sail at sunset Middle part with
equally Vatter part made sail saw Comfish Porpoise
and Comfish and we hoped to see Spum Whales

Vat by Oct 6th N. by W. 86.45 W.

Monday 8th

Commenced with strong Trades and Cloudy
Bark on the Eastern Tack by up from E. to S. E.
sailing in want of air not much. we went
out blowing day in and day out

Vat by Oct 8th N. by W. 84.00

Tuesday 9th

Nothing in sight but I presume it is
all for the best employed making their
Middle part weather cloudy Vatter part weather
more Pleasant

Vat by Oct 9th N. by W. 83.25

Wednesday 10th

Weather moderate made an sail saw Comfish
and hope soon to see whales Middle part
and I may say the Vatter the same

Vat by Oct 10th N. by W. 83.10

Thursday 11th

Weather Pleasant but nothing in sight
but our Schooner and some Black fish
and we are not certain any of them
Middle part heading to the N. Vatter part to the
Eastward nothing in sight

Vat by Oct 11th N. by W. 82.40

Friday Oct 12th 1860

Commenced with moderate Trades and
Cloudy saw a Schooner and we hope
and pray we may see Whales soon for I am
feeling rather miserable and I think a little
at sea. to be in would be a good
at sunset Tack Red to the Westward by up N. by W.
Vatter part saw Black fish but got none Bark
on the Eastern Tack by up E. to S. and two Barks

Vat by Oct 12th N. by W. 82.40

Saturday 13th

Commenced with moderate Trades and
and got one Black fish and hope next to get
a Spum Whale Middle Vatter part weather cloudy
nothing in sight

Vat by Oct 13th N. by W. 82.40

Sunday 14th

Bark heading to Eastward

Monday 15th

Saw and examined with Bark Calender
stopped in beam at night

Tuesday 16th

Bark heading to Eastward saw Black fish
got one

Wednesday 17th

Staying in position since from Westward

Thursday 18th

Came at anchor at 5 P.M. Bark Bury and
Schooner lying here anchored in. Five Barks
with 30 Sashmen of Chain
