but nothing in sight but a Bark Val of Oct 14th 1860 Nov 27th 1860

Wednesday 28th
Fine weather and we sincerely hope to see whales
in the morning Middle & Water part weather
fine saw one Bark and many Blackfish
and hope and pray to see Sperm whale soon
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Nov 28th 1860

Thursday 29th
Weather fine saw many Porpoises at sunset
Jack of up 6 Middle & Water part Breeze light
1. the eastward and say to say nothing in sight
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Nov 29th 1860

Friday 30th
Oh how much we want a Whale and I hope
God will grant us soon Oil from Middle Water
part the same ship heading to eastward
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Nov 30th 1860

Saturday 1st
Commenced with moderate trade Breeze
and the Eastern Jack of up N E 10 to 15 ft with
all sail set and nothing in sight but hope
soon to get some Oil from Middle & Water part weather
the same saw several ships
one Whales
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 1st 1860

Sunday 2nd
Commenced with Pleasant trade Breeze and the
Jack of up N E 10 to 15 ft with all sail set
and nothing in sight but hope
we shall soon be favored with a Sperm whale
Middle & Water part weather Pleasant
saw Cowfish and Garfish
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 2nd 1860

Monday Dec 3rd 1860
Commenced with fine weather at 3 PM fair Breeze
to the N E made all sail but the foremast to be taken
hope soon to see Sperm Whales Middle part weather
off shore Water part at 2 PM Jack of up to the eastward
saw three Barks and Blackfish Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 3rd 1860

Tuesday 4th
Commenced with strong trade Breeze and the Eastern
Jack of up 8 to 10 ft at sunset Jack of up 10 to 12 ft
Middle part weather cloudy Water part saw several
Barks and ships at 9 AM spoke ship Independent of Boston
fisher Master 12 to 15 but 250 Bbls Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 4th 1860
Nov 1st 1860

Wednesday 5th
Commenced with strong trade Breeze and the
Jack of up 10 to 12 ft. Commenced with ship in sight
at 9 PM came on Board and and filling the
muzz of some Oil by much and hope the
soughty racks of all things will be made
and wish
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 5th 1860

Thursday 6th
Commenced with strong trade Breeze and the
Eastern Jack of up 10 to 12 ft and saw 6 or 7 sail
Middle part heading off shore weather fine Water
part at 2 PM Board ship 1. the eastward at 5 PM
Board 1. the 2nd saw a Bark at 10 AM saw
the morning saw all sail at 11 AM saw
whales at 11 AM
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 6th 1860
Nov 1st 1860



Friday 7th
Commenced with Pleasant trade Breeze and the
Jack of up 10 to 12 ft and saw 6 or 7 sail
Middle part heading off shore weather fine Water
part at 2 PM Board ship 1. the eastward at 5 PM
Board 1. the 2nd saw a Bark at 10 AM saw
the morning saw all sail at 11 AM saw
whales at 11 AM
Val of Oct 14th 1860 Dec 7th 1860
Nov 1st 1860
