Employed Boiling at 3 P.M. further and and by
Thankful Providence and saw past along the
and nothing in sight Lat 40° 16' 53"

Monday 3rd
Employed during night but there is nothing in
sight and a light at some place where
as in a heap of good Traders strong and ready for
weather for seeing Whales

Tuesday 4th
Cruising but without any success but we hope
to make some soon and can say is good ground
we may soon feel the rest - (Blue)

Wednesday 5th
Cruising and Traders strong hoping for better
weather saw Blackfish several but got none
and I have seen that time that they would be
hard to catch Lat 40° 16' 55" Long 165° 16'

Thursday 6th
Traders strong and nothing in sight and can say
good will be done Lat 40° 16' 29" Long 165° 16'

Friday 7th
Weather Pleasant Traders light and fair the first
at sunset and sail in the light sails there are
and better part weather fine

Saturday 8th
Weather Pleasant and very much and happy

Sunday 9th 1860
Weather fine but no Whales hope to see some soon
Very strong to enjoy himself and all that is lacking
is a little good luck and hope that will come
along soon Weather & Water part weather the same
nothing in sight and we are very much in want
Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Monday 10th
Weather Good but nothing in sight but we hope
and pray we may soon get some good Weather
& Water part weather the same but nothing in sight
and I am really feeling blue Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Tuesday 11th
Commenced with strong Traders and we are
cruising but sorry to say nothing in sight
Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Wednesday 12th
Commenced with Pleasant Traders saw
the land and many Sulphur Bottoms
at 3 P.M. heard Ship off shore and started to
make all part the same Water part same as
Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Thursday 13th
Commenced with strong Traders came west
at sunset - continued fair and fine and
I hope to see Whales soon Weather & Water part
Traders strong saw many Blackfish and that
we may see some Whales soon
Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Friday 14th
Commenced with strong Traders & Water of saw many Blackfish
Weather & Water part weather the same
Lat 40° 16' 53" Long 165° 16'

Saturday 15th
Commenced with strong Traders Bait came west
saw five Ships & Bait but no Whales hope to see some soon
