and water marks many in air all day

Friday 2nd Jan 1861
Day 14.50 Long 10.10

Commenced with Pleasant Trades commencing with ship's head
heading N. E. & under easy sail salt water heading N.

Saturday 3rd Jan 1861
Day 14.35 Long 10.10

Commenced with Pleasant Trades at 2 PM Jacked to ENE
at sunset shortened sail middle part water N. & S. & S. & S.
Salt water saw Blackfish

Sunday 4th Jan 1861
Day 14.16 Long 10.10

Commenced with with Blackfish regatta
all under and under at 6 PM equal
shortened sail middle part trades more things
Salt water at daylight made sail at midday
Mina ship 1/2 up ENE

Day 14.51 Long 10.10

Monday 5th Jan 1861

Commenced with strong trades at 3 1/4 PM saw a Black
N. & E. made all sail at 4 PM saw the whale's spout
at 4 PM saw the whale and got close and cut the throat
and gave the whale may get some more tomorrow middle part
spout of the whale salt water cut in the whale and made sail
at midday saw a Black Murre



Tuesday 6th Jan 1861

Pleasant Trades made all sail and hauled the boat
at a whale at 5 PM took him along side and cut his
throat and hope the whale's spout will be no more
a light at some more middle part spout of the whale salt water
at 5 1/4 AM commenced cutting at 6 AM finished but dark in night
cutting saw many Blackfish & Porpoises Day 15.05 Long 10.10

Wednesday Jan 23rd 1861

Commenced with Pleasant Trades commenced sailing and we
are feeling very thankful for all we have much in want
saw a ship to the N. & E. middle part water fine salt water
at 2 AM saw a ship to the E. & E. at 5 AM saw a ship to the
N. & E. saw many Blackfish and Porpoises and one Black Murre

Thursday 24th Jan 1861

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on the N. & E. at
at sunset saw a ship 1/2 up E. & E. employed sailing and
at ready for some more in the morning God bless my ship
some is my enemy with and Pigeons in air & salt water with
fine fresh water and we are ready for some more

Friday 25th Jan 1861

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on the N. & E. at 4 PM spoke
Bark Hula N. & E. for a Bark made 12 PM and 14 PM Capt. Cook and
his Coffin came on board and we had a very Pleasant time made sail
heading N. & E. salt water to the E. & E. at 5 AM went in B. and the Hula
and exchanged some Hops left at 9 and stood in N. & E. the Eastward
Saw a Black Murre 14.02 Long 10.10

Saturday 26th Jan 1861

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on the Eastern Tack at
sunset Jacked and shortened sail middle part the same
salt water made sail

Sunday 27th Jan 1861

Commenced with strong Trades Bark on the N. & E. saw Porpoises
Blackfish and hope to have a light at some whales soon
middle part lying under short sail salt water made sail
at 4 PM saw strong small cones to day for spirit but they have
dried out and to be much better we are hoping for the best
and with more whales

Day 14.22 Long 10.10

Monday 28th Jan 1861

Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark on the Eastern Tack 1/2 up
E. & E. at sunset Jacked 1/2 up N. & E. in the light sails
middle part Jacked 1/2 up salt water Jacked 1/2 up 1/2 up
Day 14.32 Long 10.10
