

Sunday 10th March 1861

Commenced with squally weather but we hope for better weather and some whales with seals and Phasant took Valt. Obs 32.00
Var. Ch. 70.48 W

Monday 11th

Commenced with strong Breeze from N.E. at 4 P.M. Jacked N.E. & Middle part weather the same Valt. part more moderate nothing in sight Valt. Obs 31.50
Var. Ch. 69.20 W

Tuesday 12th

Commenced with moderate Breeze from S.E. Back on the Starboard Jack hope saw a Bark standing to N.W. Middle part very Valt. part Pleasant but nothing in sight hope to have a sight at some Whales soon Valt. Obs 31.36
Var. Ch. 68.20 W

Wednesday 13th

Commenced with Pleasant Breeze from S.E. Back by up N.E. & E. & N.E. nothing in sight but hope to see some Whales by soon middle & Valt. part by up E.N.E. until 11.30 M. Jacked to the Southward by up S.E. & N.E. Valt. Obs 30.58
Var. Ch. 67.45 W

Thursday 14th

Commenced with light Breeze from S.E. & E. Back by up from S.W. to S.E. and we see by much in want of some Whales Middle & Valt. part weather Calm Valt. Obs 31.42
Var. Ch. 67.52 W

Friday 15th

Commenced with light air and Calm saw Seaprops and hope soon to see some Whales Middle and Valt. part wind from the Westward

Saturday March 16th 1861

Commenced with strong westerly winds Commenced E. & Middle & Valt. part the same Valt.

Sunday 17th

Commenced with strong S.W. winds Commenced Middle part strong strong at daylight saw massed Chaguis distant at 10 A.M. sent in two fishing saw three Whalers got some fish

Monday 18th

Commenced with Pleasant Breeze from S.W. Middle and Valt. part Calm Valt. Obs 31.42
Var. Ch. 68.20 W

Tuesday 19th

Calm nothing in sight

Wednesday 20th

Commenced with moderate air and Calm all hands employed doing nothing Valt. Obs 31.22
Var. Ch. 67.13 W

Thursday 21st

Commenced with light Breeze from S.E. Back by the wind by up N.E. & E. saw many Puffins

Friday 22nd

Anchored at Salakuan

Saturday 23rd

Shipped 130 Bbls of Bark Anise

Sunday 24th

Shipped 313 Bbls of Bark Chaguis

Tuesday 25th

Commenced with strong westerly winds Valt. part wind from S.W. to S.W. by night and Put to Sea
