with 30 fathoms of chain

Employed getting water

Ship ready for sea at 10 AM got under
weigh and put to sea and am hope
to be favoured with a new good catch

Wednesday 20th

Two Merchant vessels in sight Middle
part blowing strong took in the light sails
and reefed the topsails Var. 400/2000

Thursday 21st

Commenced with strong trades Bark heading
in shore by up SE at 2 PM Breeze
of Shore by up SE at 10 PM Middle & have
the same Breeze towards Plover

Friday 22nd

Commenced with strong trades Breeze to
windward Middle & have part the same

Saturday 23rd

Trying to get to Plover at 11 AM Bark of the Plover
at Musoran. Lumber Bark off to sea
