Tuesday March 18th 1862
Commenced with strong Trades and nothing
in sight and we are bound South after
something to. Cruise another year as we all
I can say is - I hope the blessed Mother
of all things will prosper us for without
his aid we are rather I shall be miserable
oh dear how much good a little bit would
do us

Monday 24th
Weather Beautiful and we have seen
Puffins to day and have been setting up
some Pigeon Shocks for Bred and others
but I should like to fill them with oil
instead
Lat. 31.00 Lon. 93.50

Tuesday 25th
I feel in a hurry to get in to get some oil and
the oil would come the most explicable
havior I am in a hurry to bring things to order
with those I have got to discharge and by
another good load just we may make up a bag
and get Home. Middle part light air calm -
weather the same and back in sight saw
several Pieces of Squid
Lat. 31.51 Lon. 96.13

Wednesday 26th
Commenced with light air from ESE Breeze
at 5 P.M. wind shifted to SE. Middle & Water
part a light air from SE. Calm E with all sail set
Lat. 32.45 Lon. 94.53

Thursday 27th
Commenced with light air from Northward
Calm E with all sail set saw some European
Middle part wind from W to South Water part
strong from SE Breeze at 6 P.M. with all
sail set
Lat. 32.50 Lon. 93.36

Bound Towards Saleh name and Hope to take a Whale

Friday March 28th 1862
Commenced with moderate Breeze from SE
Bark and the Tack by up ESE with all sail set
Lat. 32.40 Lon. 92.20

Saturday 29th
Commenced with strong Breeze from Eastward
Bark and the Tack by up SE with all sail set
Wind did part the same same part at 5 P.M.
head ship to the SE by E at 8 P.M. by up NNE
Lat. 33.20 Lon. 92.31

Sunday 30th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the Eastward
by up NNE at 4 P.M. head ship by up SE & wind
shifted to Northward. Middle & Water part
Breeze by up SE by E with all sail set gave for home
a puffing this morning
Lat. 34.40 Lon. 91.58

Monday 31st
Commenced with light Breeze from the ESE
middle 2 P.M. Calm but it is all mud for some good
middle & Water part a light air from the Northward
Calm E by N with all sail set
Lat. 35.15 Lon. 90.50

Tuesday April 1st
Commenced with light air from the NW
Calm ESE with all sail set nothing in sight
weather Beautiful. Middle & Water part the same
Lat. 35.15 Lon. 90.50

Wednesday 2nd
Commenced with light air from NW
Calm ESE with all sail set saw many
Puffins in sight and we still hope to get
a Whale. Good home we are in want of oil
and more middle & Water part weather fine
and all that is lacking is some oil
Lat. 35.15 Lon. 90.50
