

Saturday May 17th 1862

Commenced with light Breezes from N. & N.W.
Bark heading N. N.E. at 2 P.M. & Ship by up to N
Middle & Vatter part weather cloudy
Lat 40° 35' N. Long 121° 16' W.

Sunday 18th

Commenced with strong Breezes from N. & N.W.
Bark by up to N. N.E. & N.W. weather cloudy
Wind all part blowing strong Bark by up to N. N.E.
Vatter part bark & ship by up to N. N.E. & N.
Lat 40° 34' N. Long 121° 17' W.

Monday 19th

Commenced with strong Breezes from Westward
Bark by up to N. N.E. & N.W. weather some rain
hope to have it pleasant soon and get some fish
Middle & Vatter part weather the same
Lat 40° 33' N. Long 121° 15' W.

Tuesday 20th

Commenced with strong Breezes from Westward
Bark by up to N. N.E. & N.W. weather easy sail at 5 P.M.
had a heavy squall from N.W. but without damage
we are ready in want of Whales and hope soon to get some
Middle part calm area and some rain Vatter part
mixed from N. & strong breeze N. N.W.
Lat 40° 31' N. Long 121° 15' W.

Wednesday 21st

Commenced with strong Breezes from N. & N.W.
Course N. N.W. weather fairish broken and
we hope soon to get a Whale Middle part calm
Vatter part a light Breeze from S.E. Course N. N.W.
saw many Birds and a few small Black fish
Lat 40° 30' N. Long 121° 16' W.

Thursday 22nd

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from S.E. Course
N. N.W. & N. with all sail set and we want a Whale
Middle & Vatter part weather good but nothing
in sight but Birds
Lat 40° 27' N. Long 121° 17' W.

Friday May 23rd 1862

Commenced with moderate Breezes from N. & N.W.
Course N. N.W. with all cruising sail set Middle part
Course N. N.W. Vatter part N. N.W.
Lat 40° 26' N. Long 121° 17' W.

Saturday 24th

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from S.E. Course
West at sunset shortened sail to hope to see some
Whales Middle part the same Vatter part same
saw the Island of St. Felix
Lat 40° 25' N. Long 121° 18' W.

Sunday 25th

Commenced with moderate Breezes from S.E.
Course N. N.W. with all cruising sail set and ready
in want of some fish Middle part same light
Vatter part Course N. N.W.
Lat 40° 24' N. Long 121° 18' W.

Monday 26th

Commenced with light Breezes from S.E. Bark
by the Wind by up to N.E. Middle & Vatter part wind
light almost a Calm
Lat 40° 23' N. Long 121° 18' W.

Tuesday 27th

Commenced with light fair and calm Bark by up
to N.E. & N. employed in various jobs Middle & Vatter
part weather good but no wind
Lat 40° 22' N. Long 121° 18' W.

Wednesday 28th

Commenced with moderate Breezes from the N. N.W.
Course N.E. & E. Middle & Vatter part the same
Lat 40° 24' N. Long 121° 19' W.

Thursday 29th

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from the N. N.W.
N.E. saw a Bundle of Prong to be a timber back Middle part
part the same
Lat 40° 23' N. Long 121° 19' W.

Friday 30th

Commenced with Pleasant Breezes from S.E. Course N.E.
saw Humpbacks and hope to see some Whales soon
Middle part the same Vatter part saw some fish
Lat 40° 22' N. Long 121° 19' W.
