Weather Good saw 10 whales water past saw several  
ships

Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup>

Weather Good Employed Steamer Air

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup>

Weather the same finished and left ship for

Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup>

Plenty of ships and no whales In hopes to see some  
soon 180 Bbls would do us a sight of good business

Friday 24<sup>th</sup>

Nothing remarkable some Chinabarks & Blackfish  
saw 100 water past the same

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup>

Weather Good hauled with hook and line  
Chase Master (boat) 250 Bbls Spent 6 hours station  
from Master & Edw. Gay Manned 1st hand

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>

Weather Good saw Blackfish three ships in sight

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>

Weather Good but no whales in sight

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup>

Weather Good several ships in sight

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup>

all things about the same plenty of ships but no whales

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup>

Weather Good at 3 PM hauled with hook and line

Friday 31<sup>st</sup>

Weather Good but we only want some whales to make  
things go smooth plenty of ships & boats in sight

Saturday Nov 1<sup>st</sup> 1862

Weather Good

Monday 2<sup>nd</sup>

all things the same

Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup>

nothing worth mentioning

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>

all things remaining the same

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup>

all things the same plenty of ships & boats

Friday 6<sup>th</sup>

commenced with several ships

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>

started for weather bay for Monday

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>

Boats into the bay

Monday 9<sup>th</sup>

at 5 PM Anchored in 13 fathoms of water 65 fathoms  
chain. Water past & employed a Monday

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>

Employed the same

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> same thing

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> about the same

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> Parted from anchor

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> Employed a day for the hook

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> the same

Monday 16<sup>th</sup> have not secured the hook

Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> but under weigh

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> Put up to South Head

Thursday 19<sup>th</sup>

Boats arrived from South Head got 96 T. per

Friday 20<sup>th</sup>

hauled with hook and caught some fish

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup>

Stung 8 & 6 had a boat from Capt. Tamm  
& Capt. Kelly

Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup>

Came 1 & 8 saw Whinnies Island
