Commenced with moderate N.W. breeze from N.E. commenced making the ice saw a large ship strong N.E. breeze & calm part breeze rather from strong

Commenced with strong breeze from N.E. corner E.N.E. with all sail set Amadeo & Vash put blowing strong corner E.N.E.

Tuesday 31st

Commenced with strong breeze from Westward corner E.N.E. with all sail set weather calm at 5:30 PM. much had saw Massapequa Island being E.N. breeze & calm part wind strong with rain

Wednesday April 1st

Commenced with strong winds from N.W. corner E.N.E. at 7 PM. suffered to the wind to the S.W. blowing strong with rain calm part heard ship at daylight started off E.N.E. at 10 PM. saw four from hand by

Thursday 2nd

Commenced with strong winds standing southward of the Island at 2 PM. spoke B.K. Helian from Capt. Adams & 6 M^{en} out of 170 Bells. Made a part made a part

Friday 3rd

Commenced with strong winds corner E.N. made a part made the same Va the part Southward the Lopez took in the boat

Commenced with strong winds from Southward corner E.N. at 11 AM. spoke B.K. Helian from Amadeo weather the same calm part lost in the S. part and first the S. sail & employed a Sunday the Boat

Commenced with strong winds from Southward B.K. corner E.N. at 11 AM. spoke B.K. Helian from Amadeo weather the same calm part lost in the S. part and first the S. sail & employed a Sunday the Boat

Monday 6th

Commenced with moderate breeze from Westward at 5 PM. came at Amadeo in 21 fathoms water and 6 fathoms chain

Tuesday 7th

The Capt. of Post came to the ship to be married

Wednesday 8th

weather head back on Amadeo and B.K. Helian what I expected

Thursday 9th

trying hard to draw money to pay and expenses

Friday 10

weather head and shore the Amadeo of land money for 10 per cent to be paid in Amadeo held

Saturday 11

Got the money paid my Bill and P.A. to sea being calm took the steamer Pinaffo

Sunday 12

B.K. entered saw Humphreys

Monday 13th

wind from Westward B.K. by up 1/2

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with light and land calm saw two ships & B.K. Helian & Vash part weather the same
