Commenced with light breezes from southward
course N by W and hope to see some whales soon
middle part weather the same latter part
strove N N E commenced painting
Lat 42° 23.51' Lon 134° 50'

Thursday 4th
Commenced with strong trade winds course N N E
at sunset strove N N W middle & latter part
weather the same
Lat 42° 00'

Friday 5th
Weather good trades strong course N N W
middle & latter part weather the same
employed painting
Lat 42° 21.50' Lon 134° 50'

Saturday 6th
Light trades weather good
Lat 42° 20.21' Lon 134° 51'

Sunday 7th
Light trades no whales but we hope to get
some soon for this is our last year
middle & latter part weather the same
Lat 42° 19.45' Lon 134° 50'

Monday 8th
Trades more strong course N N middle & latter part
the same
Lat 42° 17.55' Lon 134° 50'

Tuesday 9th
Trades strong course N N middle 11 AM strove N
saw many Finbacks
had a fair weather spent the day with Capt. Allen of the Ship Venus had a long time
Lat 42° 16.35' Lon 134° 50'

Wednesday June 10th 1863
At sunset strove N N E course N N at daylight
strove N N E saw the land and strove N N
Lat 42° 15.26' Lon 134° 50'

Thursday 11th
Trades strong course N N at sunset strove N N
Lat 42° 15.26' Lon 134° 50'

Friday 12th
Trades at Chumka Islands got some sugar

Saturday 13th
Left the Islands with a case of Small Pox
in company with Ship Venus

Sunday 14th
Strong trades the man with Small Pox getting
along fine

Monday 15th
Strong trades course N N W with moderate
sail set no more sails as yet hope not
to have any more

Tuesday 16th
Weather the same no more sails

Wednesday 17th
Trades strong course N N under easy sail
middle & latter part the same

Thursday 18th
Weather the same course N N

Friday 19th
Weather more moderate trade with Small Pox
much better and no more sails

Saturday 20th
Course N N W and we see what is to come
the Archad Emma
hope we shall get a good lot of oil double 90.34
