

Sunday June 21st 1863
Commenced with strong Trades came off
until sunset luffed to the wind to the
wind sheet sail I hope to see some
whales in the morning Middle & Water part
wind strong saw some birds

Monday 22nd
Commenced with nearly a gale of wind
Bark and barque Tacks saw some birds Middle & Water
the same

Tuesday 23rd
Commenced with the same weather Bark
in the N.E. Tack Middle & Water part the same
found the fine topsail

Wednesday 24th
Commenced with strong Trades bent a new
Foremast Bark and the southern Tack by 10
at sunset bent a Ship to N.E. Middle part
the same same part bent a Ship to Southern
employed repairing the Foremast

Thursday 25th
Commenced with strong Trades but outside
strong as they have been employed repairing the
Foremast at 5 P.M. bent it weather moderate
and we are I hope to see some Whales in
Middle & Water part weather good

Friday 26th
Commenced with Pleasant Trades Bark coming
nothing in sight but Ships & Barks

Saturday 27th
Commenced with Pleasant Trades coming
weather fine but no Whales yet

Sunday June 28th 1863
Commenced with strong Trades Middle & Water
the same Commenced with Ship Bark Southern
Group Master 34 they met 3 or 4 sperm whales
Vat of the 19th 57 Hong 91.4.57

Monday 29th
Commenced with strong Trades at sunset bent a
sail to double as yet depends on hope to get some
Whales soon Middle & Water part weather in good and nothing
in sight but one Ship Bark in the N.E. Tack

Tuesday 30th
Commenced with strong Trades & equally Bark and the
N.E. Tack at sunset bent a Ship to the Southern
and this is the last day of June hope we shall get
a sperm whale in a week or there is something

Wednesday July 1st
Commenced with Pleasant Trades coming but
don't see any Whales hope for the best
and good help

Thursday 2nd
Commenced with Pleasant Trades saw some
Barks and now & then a bark we shall be
in hope and ask for the help of the strong
Vat of the 20th 58 Hong 91.38

Friday 3rd
Commenced with Pleasant Trades saw some
Barks and some barks hope to see sperm
Whales next Middle & Water part weather good

Saturday 4th
Commenced with moderate Trades & equally
and nothing in sight that is no Whales we shall hope
but that it may not be in vain. Found the South
the Bay of the hood had quite a fine young humpback
and in the evening a couple of other whales

Sunday 5th
Weather squally saw a large ship strong to N.W.
