Commenced with strong Trades Bark heady to the
Northward took up S.E. nothing in sight
but we think we shall see some Whales soon
Saw several with Hump back & saw several other
has not taken anything since leaving Labrador

Commenced with strong Trades Mackerel & latter part
the same Bark heady to the Southward

Monday July 13th 1863

ship to S.E. & S.E. latter part at daylight heard
ship to the Southward

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with strong Trades Bark heady to the Southward
took up S.E. and Mackerel and heard for Blackfish
but got no hope about it. Mackerel and heard several
and got some Mackerel & latter part weather good

Lat 40.20.40 N Long 90.50.0 W

Wednesday 15th

Weather about the same and no Whales and no
sailing in want

Lat 40.19.50 N Long 90.50.0 W

Thursday 16th

Weather seen better but no Whales at 4 P.M. heard
with Bark Islander near the last back Mackerel

Lat 40.19.50 N Long 90.50.0 W

Friday 17th

Weather squally and a little we could get some Whales
for the time is going weather about the same
and no Whales

Saturday 18th

all things the same

Sunday 19th

Commenced with Bark heady to the S.E. & saw
several
