large whale him part at 10 PM took the last of the

part cut them in

Capt Adams came on Board employed B. B.

Friday 21st

Finished a Boat and am ready for more and
hope soon to get home

Saturday 22nd

Plenty of Ships but no Whales

Sunday 23rd

The Ships are mostly Barks

Monday 24th

Weather good saw Blackfish but could not catch any

Tuesday 25th

Saw one Black in sight and saw many more but
and we are by the Whales which it was a large pair

Wednesday 24th Sept 1863

Finished strong down and we hope soon to be strong
Again came under with Bark under short sail with
masts

Thursday 25th

Weather looking sharp have seen a Whales which
has been seen again Tuesday last

Friday 26th

Weather always good and we hope to see some
Whales soon

Saturday 27th

Bark cruising but nothing in sight but Barks and Barks

Sunday 28th

Cruising but nothing in sight hope to get some soon

Monday 29th

at 10 PM came under with Bark under short sail with
Black masts

Tuesday 30th

I have made a mistake in date but the way
to be sure took in having two dates or rather two
different days and date hope then may

Wednesday 31st

Commenced with good weather but no Whales

Thursday 1st Oct

Weather good plenty Barks but no Whales cruising for Whales
and commencing

Friday 2nd

Weather always good plenty of Barks and we are still
spoon Whales will strike and we feel the need
of getting some more soon

Things about the same cruising off the Bays

Sunday 4th

Saw some Barks and some of them better off B. B.

Monday 5th

not quite so many Barks
