

Remarks on board Scho Clara L Sparks

Wednesday Aug 2

Begins with light winds from the SE with squally weather at daylight raised a school of Spum Whales lower down one of the boats struck, taking 2 cows in holes over 3 small calves took them alongside and commenced cutting at 11.30 finished cutting at 5.30 PM at the works going at 8.30 Lat 32.18 Lon 48.19

Thursday Aug 3

Begins with light winds from the SE clear away the heaves and waves up the blubber and cleaned up decks till a boiling Lat 32.12 Lon 48.53

Friday Aug 4

This day begins with light winds from the SE with a squally weather at 2.30 raised a school of whales lower down one chased but did not allow come on board again cow then again at 3.30 lower down and made a miss of it come on board again finished boiling at 3.30 PM Lat 32.10 Lon 48.53

Saturday Aug 5

This day begins with fresh winds and a heavy swell from the SE all hands busy stowing down lower down 48-13 barrels 140 barrels all told washed the vessel Lat 32.14 Lon 48.49

Sunday Aug 6

This day begins with light winds from the SE with a squally weather at sunrise saw a school of whales lower down and did not go for come on board in the afternoon lower again and made a miss of it Lat 32.07 Lon 49.00

Monday Aug 7

Begins with light winds from the SE with pleasant weather at about half on board before sunset saw a school of whales coming to the windward and quite lower but did not get on Lat 32.16 Lon 49.13

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Tuesday Aug 8

This day begins with fresh breezes from the SE strong is the SE at 3 PM raised a school of branches brought up for them but never saw them again Lat 32.10 Lon 48.54

Wednesday Aug 9

Begins with light winds from the SE with pleasant weather a whaling Boat on a storm in sight at daylight in the afternoon picked up some poles at unning etc Lat 32.08 Lon 48.11

Thursday Aug 10

This day commences with light winds from the SE at 1 PM was on board on to the SE at 4.30 PM. saw whales going to the SE lower but did not appear in getting any Lat 32.11 Lon 48.40

Friday Aug 11

This day begins with light winds from the SE at 1 PM was on board on to the SE at 4.30 PM. saw whales going to the SE lower but did not appear in getting any Lat 32.01 Lon 48.38

Saturday Aug 12

This day begins with light winds from the SE with a squally weather at sunrise saw a school of whales lower down and did not go for come on board in the afternoon lower again and made a miss of it Lat 32.02 Lon 48.37

Sunday Aug 13

This day begins with light winds from the SE with a squally weather at sunrise saw a school of whales lower down and did not go for come on board in the afternoon lower again and made a miss of it Lat 32.08 Lon 48.49

Monday Aug 14

This day begins with calm better port little breeze from the SE at 1 PM was on board on to the SE at 4.30 PM. saw whales going to the SE lower but did not appear in getting any Lat 32.01 Lon 48.22
