 Lat 34.48 Lon 36.25

Monday Aug 31

 the S by E Lat 34.48 Lon 36.00

Tuesday Sept 1

This day begins with light winds from the northeast
 steering to the S by E and a lot of porcupine tracking Lat 34.35 Lon 35.49

Wednesday Sept 2

This day begins with light winds from the NW
 smoky weather steering to the S by E at 3 pm from a
 sailing back at 3.30 and the main sail Lat 36.26 Lon 35.29

Thursday Sept 3

This day begins with light winds from the northeast
 with pleasant weather better than before breeze from
 the NW steering to the northeast Lat 36.46 Lon 33.10

Friday Sept 4

This day continues with light winds from the
 westward with pleasant steering to the northeast
 we sail in sight at noon Lat 37.01 Lon 32.28

Saturday Sept 5

This day begins with light winds from the northeast
 at 3.30 we saw a ship in sight we came to her which
 proved to be the Charles Thompson & mine one 180
 barrels of sperm Lat 38.14 Lon 29.30

Sunday Sept 6

Begins with light winds from the NW at daylight
 Fogel has not seen down on the land west on shore laying off
 and on the water laying at anchor

 more breeze from the same quarter laying off and on
