Thursday Sept 14

Begins with light winds from the SE, several Sds to the
windward proved to be the Gage Phillips, 9 months out 100 Bbls

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Friday Sept 15

This day begins with fresh breezes from the west-
ward of whales in sight rising SE by South

Saturday Sept 16

This day begins with fresh winds from the NE
near St. Michael at 9 o'clock came to anchor at 3 P.M.

Sunday Sept 17

Struck a to get on a Sds took out about 100 Bbls
fresh winds and much rain

Monday Sept 18

Finished our oil to day, gauged out 205 Bbls
shipped our oil by Bark Modesta
