

Remarks on board Scho. Cleaveland L Sparks

Wednesday Oct 11

Took on board some more food and water and stowed off the hole
day done with plenty of rain

Thursday Oct 12

Finished stowing the hole and cleared up the decks

Friday Oct 13

On account of the rain nothing was done to day

Saturday Oct 14

Received 40 bushels white potatoes and 60 bushels of
Irish Potatoes and 30 Bushels

Sunday Oct 15

Very rainy day with light winds from the SE

Monday Oct 16

This day wind too much could not get clear from the
Custom House as delayed sailing until to morrow

Tuesday Oct 17

Commenced hoisting from merrings at 11 o'clock
overboard off the headwater at 1 o'clock received 9 men
from shore made all sail and stood off shore took in
merrings at 10 and set the topsail and Main

Wednesday Oct 18

At daylight made all sail standing in shore light came on board
and then stood off by 1/2 passed 10 miles off shore saw 3 or 4 more SSB

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Thursday Oct 19

Whales

Began with light winds from the North at 10.30
saw a school of sperm whales bowing and made out and
and the boatmen were sent off a mile or by starting
the whales in the small while he had a chance to
strike his engine came on board and took the boat
and took the seat of his course

Friday Oct 20

This day begins with light winds from the eastward
standing to the Southward with foggy weather
Lat 34.24 Lon 22.23

Saturday 21

This day begins with light winds from the
eastward with pleasant weather latter part more
breeze
Lat 33.00 Lon 20.54

Sunday Oct 22

This day begins with light winds from the
eastward steering to the SSB much of rain
and eight latter part more breeze
Lat 34.30 Lon 19.10

Monday Oct 23

This day begins with light winds from
the SSB heading along to the Southward
middle part wind came to the Southward
heading to the Southward
Lat 30.25 Lon 18.40
