This day begins with light winds from the N & with pleasant weather steering S by E we sail in sight at sundown Lat 12.35

Thursday Dec 28

This day begins with light winds from the N & steering S by E sail in sight at sundown Lat 10.40 Lon 21.48

Friday Dec 29

Begins with light winds from the N & steering to the Southward at the usual rate a school of Blackfish lowered overboard and a school of Blackfish lowered overboard Lat 10.20 Long 21.07

Saturday Dec 30

Begins with light winds from the N & with pleasant weather a school of Blackfish lowered overboard in the afternoon and then again lowered overboard & then about noon cleared land Lat 10.20 Lon 20.50

Sunday Dec 31

Begins with light winds from the N & backing out Blackfish finished boiling Lat 10.16 Long 20.53 it was the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy seven in

Monday Jan 1 1877

This day begins with light winds from the N & steering to the S & at 10 o'clock back to the N & at 12 o'clock the North one steamed in sight from the SW Lat 10.33 Lon 20.36

Tuesday Jan 2

This day begins with light winds from the N & at 3 o'clock a school of Blackfish lowered overboard in taking me Lat 10.50 Lon 20.30

Wednesday Jan 3

Begins with light winds from the N & with pleasant weather in the afternoon however and did not succeed in getting on Lat 11.10 Long 21.05

Thursday Jan 4

This day begins with light winds from the N & about 6 AM began to breeze single reefed the main and a number of Blackfish and Porpoises Lat 11.18 Long 20.38

Friday Jan 5

Begins with fresh trade winds blowing to the North one vessel in sight in the afternoon Lat 11.30 Long 21.27

Saturday Jan 6

Begins with fresh trade winds steering to the N & saw a school of Blackfish and a number of Porpoises Lat 12.35 Long 21.43
