beginning to anchor better part more arrived all hands employed  
and breaking up the ice

Thursday Feb 1

Begins with light winds from the eastward still  
beginning to anchor at Port of Sal

Friday Feb 2

This day begins with light from the 100 get underway way  
about 3 AM and see for Bonavista come to anchor  
at Bonavista about 2.30 in more fathoms water as was  
this day

Saturday Feb 3

Get underway from Bonavista at 1 PM and  
see for the Gale of May and the Gale of June  
now down the Gale of June and the Gale of July  
come to anchor at 3 PM as was this day

Sunday Feb 4

Still lying at Port Royal with pleasant weather  
better part have been here as was this day

Monday Feb 5

Still lying in port all hands employed  
and now attending the stores and here one  
French vessel

Tuesday Feb 6

Still lying at anchor at Port Royal  
as was this day

Wednesday

Begins with light winds from  
the N.E. at 3 PM come on board of a vessel  
way over on arrival on back board in  
as was this day

Thursday Feb 8

Begins with light trade winds beating  
up the shore off the Isle of May at 3 PM raised  
a school of Blackfish between 10 and 12 come  
on board and were taken up as was this  
day

Friday Feb 9

This day begins with light trade winds  
steering to the North and a school of Blackfish  
between 10 and 12 Lat 16.20 Long 23.40

Saturday Feb 10

This day begins with light trade winds standing  
to the N.E. at 8 AM taken up a vessel to  
the N.E. at 3.30 under the land ahead  
now in and come to anchor at the Port of Sal  
in 5 fathoms water at 3 PM as was this day

Sunday Feb 11

Lying at anchor and a number of whales arrived  
from the Bay of Edgartown
