Still trying to anchor some more whole hauled
Humpback 24th we struck into the Lagoon Pool, took him along in
and commenced cutting for a few minutes at 3-Run

Tuesday Feb 13

Began with light winds, wind changed to blizzard
and snow was laid up over fuel, this in case
as the blizzard was gone

Wednesday Feb 14

Commenced with light winds, better fuel, more
wind was some whole but did not haul

Thursday Feb 15

Began with light trade winds started hauling at
3-Run arrived here after 11 miles, started
hauled 2 1/2 miles down over to anchor here

Friday Feb 16

Finished hauling at 3-Run started down over to
anchor this day

Saturday Feb 17

Got under way at 10 AM and went down to
very rough sea did not anchor to anchor some up this day
and came to anchor at the Lagoon Pool for
16 days as was this day

Sunday Feb 18

Trying to anchor but nothing unusual occurred
to day

Monday Feb 19

Got under way after breakfast and saw Humpback
hauled but did not get fuel over in one
anchored

Tuesday Feb 20

Got under way and went up in the other
bay saw a whole hauled over board but she being
what could not get on over to anchor at
10 o'clock

Wednesday Feb 21

Got under way after breakfast and went around
the head in the other bay, hauled for them
What had struck took us to the anchor and
not start any place for killing ground and took our
line in the afternoon was some more struck on
under way broke the peg, but the iron was not
cut as was this day

Thursday Feb 22

Got under way after breakfast and saw whole hauled and
Humpback 46th struck him to the water boat took him down and
commenced cutting never got through picking knocked off
number of boats along with fish along with

Friday Feb 23

Began picking up here in about 9 am commenced
working him up for a few minutes and got the decks cleared
at 11 AM and got away for hauling
