

Friday Mch 9th

Commenced cutting after breakfast finished at 12 o'clock. in the afternoon cut up the blubber. and commenced mincing knocked off at sunset.

Saturday Feb 10th

Made sail in the morning and stood off
shore hauled several times but did not strike

Sunday Feb 11th

Started the works at 5 o'clock in the morning
finished boiling at 8 in the evening.

Monday Mch 12th.

Started off in the boats, after breakfast
the larboard boat struck a whale about
12 o'clock. the whale showed no play for
killing and after repeated somittings
took the line stowed down in the afternoon 15th 1864

January Nov 13

Lowered the boats after breakfast on a number of whorls but it being very awkward did not succeed in getting down on shore at 1.30 and cleaned up decks and took the sail coaks up and took the sails out - as was the day

Wednesday (Mar) 14

How it is and having the voice heard
for some weeks but did not get any more in or a
answer at 1.30 saw the Pelota of St. Nicolas
from westward

Thursday Nov 15

Hot under way on sleds towards the town
HUMPHREY arrived some whales however and struck one so the
Naut Reed took him alongside and commenced
cutting finished cutting at 4.30 arrived at the
B & O Park

Friday Mar 18

Took him down and now we sit whole at
we began enjoying him at first he
and but he misleads so we at this way

Saturday Nov 11

Begin with calm weather better for
gentle breeze from the westward. go away
for boiling B. F. Sparks capture a
whale today

Sunday May 1

Began with light winds from the NE
blatka to boat at 1 o'clock then further Berkey
at 2.30 P.m. as was the day

Monday May 1

Begins with light trace which got more
way on a wire down from Boston House boat
toward us before we got there on a stone stone
Small Rock had taken out in Port Perry probably
on a stone stone down 20 barrels back to
the town of Bowdoin at 4.30 hours at
Port Perry as
