Monday April 16

Begins with light trade winds saw a Bark  
Bark and Schooner in sight W of us  
Lat 13.35 Long 42.45

Tuesday April 17

Begins with light winds saw a white water vessel  
but proved to be Blackfish also grounded the Schooner & Lumber  
of Boston Bark loaded 4 months out 40 Barrels Shum  
also one Bark in sight Lat 13.48 Long 43.15

Wednesday 18

Begins with light winds and pleasant weather saw a  
Bark on for it but never see it again  
Lat 13.30 Long 42.47

Thursday April 19

Begins with light winds saw a white water vessel  
for it but never see it afterwards saw one Bark  
in sight stretching to the North  
Lat 13.35 Long 43.07

Friday April 20

Begins with light winds saw one Bark  
in sight about noon Lat 13.40 Long 43.15

Saturday April 21

Begins with light trade winds nothing in sight  
running to the westward Lat 14.00 Long 43.40

Sunday April 22

This day begins with light trade winds on  
Hermaphrodite & King in sight bound to the westward  
Lat 13.35 Long 44.29

Monday April 23

Begins with light trade winds nothing in sight  
took in sail at sunset Lat 13.12 Long 43.30

Tuesday April 24

Begins with light trade winds saw a bark  
about half on bow before sunset turned due to the  
Lat 13.12 Lon 43.22

Wednesday April 25

Begins with light trade winds one Bark in sight  
standing to the north  
Lat 14.20 Long 44.33

Thursday April 26

Begins with light trade winds saw a bark  
bound to the Southward in the morning  
and some Blackfish in the afternoon  
Lat 14.10 Long 44.25
