Saturday April 28

This day begins with light trade winds and pleasant weather and sail in sight a Barbentine bound to the United States Lat 14.11 Long 45.31

Sunday April 29

This day begins with light trade winds beginning to the NNE were ship and close to the Gallinera at 8 AM Lat 14.25 Long 45.48

Monday April 30

This day commences with light winds and pleasant weather but off to the NNE wind shifts and ship and runs to the NW Lat 14.25 Long 46.18

Tuesday May 1

Begins with light winds but the swell to the NNE and at the mountains and to the NNE day we are before from here Lat 14.50

Wednesday May 2

Begins with light winds steering to the NNE better part more breeze but the swell on the upper ones Lat 16.10 Long 46.17

Thursday May 3

Begins with light trade winds with squally weather and a dolphin Lat 17.50 Long 46.50

Friday May 4

Begins with light winds and the mountains at 10 o'clock were a large swell Lat 18.00 Long 45.58

Saturday May 5

Begins with light winds running to the NNE better part more wind repeated two former Lat 21.20

Sunday May 6

Begins with fresh trade winds running to the NNE Lat 23.20

Monday May 7th

This day begins with fresh trade winds towards night more moderate running North Lat 25.08 Long 45.17

Tuesday May 8

Begins with light winds from the SW running to the NNE nothing in sight Lat 25.42

Wednesday May 9

This day begins with light winds from a number of flocks of birds at 4 PM 3 sails in sight all bound to the NW Lat 26.00 Long 45.40
