

Thursday June 14

Begins with light winds from the southeast and equally
westerly according to the Southward later part somewhat
refers the forest Lat 31.40 Long 42.09

Friday June 15

Begins with light winds from the southeast according to the
SSE about half on land and vessel above this part
off our lee bow Lat 31.24 Long 46.13

Saturday June 16

This 24 hours begins with light easterly winds and pleasant
weather caught a number of Dolphins and picked up a
hard pine plank Lat 31.16 Long 46.16

Sunday June 17

This day begins with winds from the southeast according to
the NW nothing in sight but a few porpoises later
part calm Lat 31.20 Long 46.27

Monday June 18

Begins with light ^{morning} from the SW evening to the NW
look in the morning and evening all night Lat 31.36 Long 46.38

Tuesday June 19

Begins with light easterly winds evening to the
southeast picked up a small piece of black Riboite
and saw some Sparrows and swallows Lat 32.00 Long 45.00

Wednesday June 20

Begins with light winds from the Southward evening
to the NW saw some Sparrows and swallows but did
not see any more Lat 32.20 Long 43.44

Thursday June 21

This day begins with fresh winds from the SW
according to the Southward and Eastward at 12 o'clock
ship had arrived to the NW Lat 32.10 Long 43.01

Friday June 22

Begins with light winds from the SW according
to the westward picked up a hard pine log
took it on board and covered it up Lat 32.38 Long 43.18

Saturday June 23

Begins with light winds from the Southeast
employed in cutting up the log of hard pine
and the part called ball's part light winds from
the SW Lat 32.26 Long 43.38

Sunday June 24

Begins with light winds from the Westward
at 12 o'clock the evening and half of the
evening in sight bound to the Eastward Lat 32.00 Long 43.32

Monday June 25

Begins with light winds from the NW according
to the SW picked up a small piece of Riboite
a few cabbages were a vessel off our lee bow Lat 32.50 Long 44.38

Tuesday June 26

This day begins with light winds from the SW
according to the westward saw some Sparrows and
saw some swallows and saw a small piece of Riboite
picked up a hard pine plank Lat 32.29 Long 46.28
