Begins with fresh winds from the Southward steering
to the Southward at 8 P.M. under a whaling Btg
to the Southward chasing whales but it being dark
and not get to them took in sail and fixed the
foremast to ease the day Lat 31.40 Long 48.03

Thursday July 12

This day begins with fresh breezes from the Southward
standing to the Southward the Btg in night
after the 2 P.M. backed ship and before 10 P.M.
the look in sail at sunset Lat 31.47 Long 47.30

Friday July 13

This day begins with light winds from the Southward
running to the S.W. at 12 backed ship and under the
S.W. at 1 P.M. under a breeze on for ship proved to
be sperm whales however for them and struck a large
whale to the Southward and under the wind boat
took him alongside about 4.30 and gave the cutting gear
Lat 31.54 Long 48.11

but it being very rough did not get his boat off
until 11 o'clock finished cutting at 8 P.M. and set
the work going at 10 o'clock Lat 32.20 Long 48.08

with the fresh in sail a sailing

Begins with light winds from the S.W.
with a backing nothing in night but under sail
broad to the S.W. finished Lat 33.33 Long 47.36
backing at 9.30 and set the foremast

Tuesday July 17

Begins with light winds from the S.W.
steering to the S.W. and one back and on
S.W. in night one the vessel down and spoke
no power to the S.W. the vessel of the vessel
4 months and 15 Bbbs store a soon 20 Bbbs
Lat 33.10 Long 48.02
